



Health Education Volunteer

United Action for Youth is seeking a volunteer to supplement their Health Education Program. The volunteer will work closely with the Health Educator to develop and promote sexual health education materials and provide support for programmatic activities. Volunteer should have an interest in reproductive health, comprehensive sex education, and be committed to the equity and inclusion of all people.

Qualifications:

- Preferred student in Public Health, Health Promotion, Nursing, Medicine, Social Work, or related
- Self-motivated with the ability to work independently, but also cooperatively with the Health Educator
- Strong social media skills
- Comfort with adolescent populations
- Knowledge of a range of sexual health topics such as birth control, sexually transmitted infections, gender identity, and sexual orientation.

Responsibilities:

Under supervision of the Health Educator

- Post sexual health-related content to social media accounts (1-2 times weekly)
- Create topical sexual health bulletin for UAY restrooms (monthly)
- Condom distribution and tracking within UAY
- Shadow and assist with Health Educator's lessons in Iowa City schools and other events as needed
- Assist in preparation of materials for classes
- Represent UAY and serve as the Health Educator's liaison at monthly Sexual Health Alliance coalition meetings (first Thursday of the month)

Commitment:

5-10 hours per week, at least 1 year commitment. Hours are flexible and can mostly be done from home with occasional on-site responsibilities.
